### Black Marble Hill Syrah 2013

With stewed black fruit, aromatic spice and integrated oak characters, this wine confidently reflects elegant and generous Shiraz styling. Smooth-textured with freshness still evident, the juicy palate allows for immediate enjoyment, yet with further ageing potential if cellared perfectly.

### Vinification

<i>Balling:</i>	<i>26° B at harvest</i>
<i>Fermentation :</i>	<i>Cold maceration Fermentation on the skins in stainless steel tanks with a selected yeast strain Regular pumpovers</i>
<i>Oaking:</i>	<i>4 x 300l French oak barrels. 100% new</i>
<i>Aging:</i>	<i>Matured in oak barrels for 24 months before bottling and then for a further two years in bottle prior to release</i>
